**Region 4 Championship Show Commission**

Sue Irwin announced that prize lists are posted on the website. Tony Van Wyck is working on securing Patrons. Two show commissioners, Judy Booth and Peggy Weems terms are expiring and we thank them for their volunteerism. #### **Region 4 Championship Show Judge's Selection Committee**

The 2010 Judge's Selection List has been completed and they are working on securing judges from that list for the 2010 Championship Show now. Two committee members, Doug Stewart and Kaye Phaneuf terms are expiring and we also thank them for their volunteerism. Nominations of Kaye Phaneuf and Lisa Kolke were made from the floor as new committee members. **Motion #2009-04** passed.

#### **Dressage / Sport Horse**

An advertisement for all of the Region 4 AHA Dressage/Sport Horse events was placed in the ODS Omnibus and distributed to 1200 ODS members. Shows included AiM Back 2 Basics; Rogue Valley Spring Festival (which was canceled), AHBAO, AHACO, AiM Sport Horse Classic and Region 4 AHA Sport Horse Championships. The AiM Sport Horse Classic and Region 4 AHA Sport Horse Championships Show will be at the Devonwood Equestrian Center on August 7-9, 2009. Most officials have been hired. Jennifer Milbourn will be show manager, Jean Beck and Annette Wells will run the show office. Need to expand advertising. FEI Classes will be broken out to 4 levels instead of "Test Of Choice" to meet AHA requirements.

#### **Breed Promotion**

Chris Bickford reported on the Albany Horse Expo demonstration. Russ Brown, Harmony Pugh, Chris Bickford, Kate Brown, Michael Hartman, Peggy Weems all presented horses. Chris suggested that the script from the Expo be posted. PNER also had a booth at the Expo and they were impressed with the Arabian demonstration and they would like to add an Arabian Endurance horse to the demonstration next year. Margo stated that they have made many improvements to the show schedule and facility flow to make it more manageable and enjoyable for everyone.

### **Benefit Activities Committee**

Kaye Phaneuf and Judy Booth agreed that the \$40 AHA recognition fee for Endurance rides benefited the Arabian breed and that Janelle Wilde could submit her invoice to the regional treasurer for reimbursement from this committee.

### **Distance (Endurance & Competitive Trail)**

Janelle Wilde reported. Sweepstakes qualifying rides are very difficult to administer. Janelle is working with the National Distance Committee to settle some of these issues. AHA is reaching out to find new locations for National Rides. (see AHA BOD minutes/notes) This year's National Ride will be held in Oklahoma and is an AERC approved ride. Come to the PNER annual convention, usually held in January, which features speakers, an awards dinner, and oodles of vendors. PNER Year End High Point Award is sponsored by Region 4 AHA and is open to any AHA member, riding a registered Purebred or Half Arabian. Points are accumulated at 1 point per mile (1½ per mile at the Region IV Championship), based on horse/rider team. Only rides within Region IV will count. All distances are eligible for points. An achievement award will be given to all who accumulate 200 points or more. There is a \$10 nomination fee for each horse/rider combination. Riders must submit proof of AHA membership and horse registration to AHA representative prior to any points accumulation. #### **Region 4 Directory**

Since the official announcement was made via E-mail blast on April 6<sup>th</sup>, the rules as published will allow exhibitors who showed at Rally In The Valley **AND Arabians In Motion Back 2 Basics shows** (not previously publicized) to claim those points as long as their enrollment form is received before the close of the AHBAO show on April 19<sup>th</sup>.
